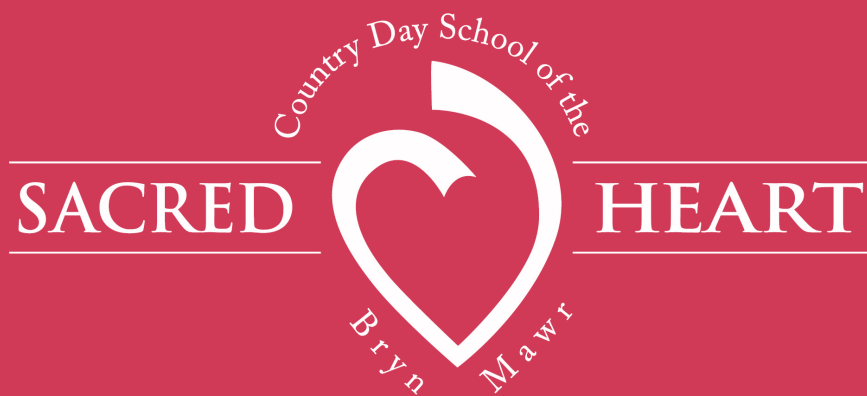

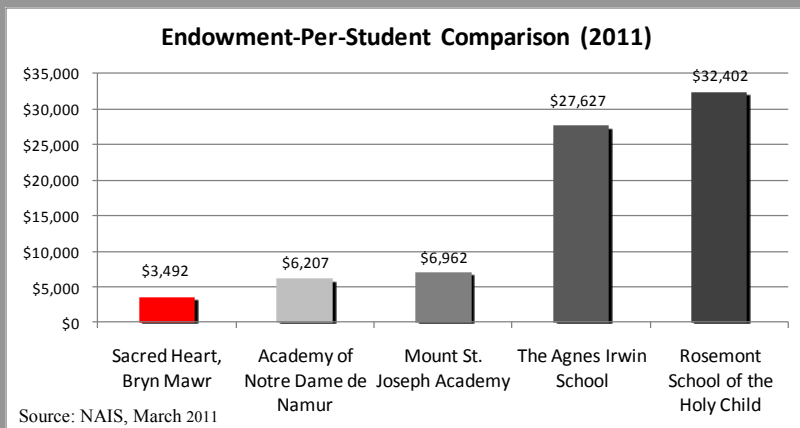

*Campaign Goal: \$8,000,000*

***Endowment for Tuition Assistance and Educational Enrichment — \$3,500,000***



As the chart above indicates, Sacred Heart’s endowment currently ranks behind many independent schools in the important endowment-per-student comparison. With the One Heart One Vision Campaign, we hope to rectify this. We seek support for an Endowment for Tuition Assistance and Educational Enrichment. Returns on this investment will increase the need-based financial assistance packages we provide to families. Tuition Assistance will enable students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds to attend Sacred Heart. It will further our effort to create a true microcosm of our world within the classroom and retain students who demonstrate a financial need.

***Endowment for Faculty and Staff Development—\$2,000,000***

Sacred Heart will create an endowment for faculty and staff development. This will fund educators’ compensation and participation in workshop experiences designed by the Sacred Heart Network. Those



programs will deepen their connection with our mission and enable them to act more fully as spiritual and moral resources for our students.

The Fund will also support post-baccalaureate faculty and staff education, encouraging them to embrace continuing education and generate excitement for learning in the classroom.

***Capital Renovations to Support Technology and Science—\$1,500,000***

To prepare our students to succeed in tomorrow’s world, Sacred Heart must create a networked environment and provide cutting-edge technology in the classroom. In order to achieve these goals, we will invest in air-conditioning for the School House and Dooley buildings as well as state-of-the art equipment for our science laboratories. This will support the implementation of an integrated science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) program.



***Investment in Facilities and Physical Health Programs—\$600,000***



Funds will be used to renovate the gymnasium’s locker rooms; updating the school’s locker room facilities is a necessity for Sacred Heart’s ten active sports teams and many student athletes. Athletic coaches are an invaluable part of a student athlete’s school experience; retaining outstanding coaches who can provide a consistent coaching philosophy is essential to a strong athletic program; campaign funds will also be used to provide competitive salaries for athletic coaches.

***Growth of the Annual Fund—\$400,000***

Sacred Heart’s Annual Fund is the lifeblood of the school; it provides the unrestricted operating support that is so essential to running the school and enhancing student, faculty, and community life. Increasing the size of our Annual Fund will improve our students’ school experience by giving the Board of Trustees and Head of School a greater ability to tend to the school’s most immediate needs quickly and effectively.
